




THURSDAY WORKSHOPS

SESSION I

Developing Strategies for Community Engagement

PRESENTERS: SEAN CASEY, SENIOR VICE PRESIDENT, ERIC MOWER & ASSOCIATES, AND BRENDAN KENNEDY, SENIOR COUNSELOR, ERIC MOWER & ASSOCIATES

Community engagement campaigns can be an important tool for municipalities when looking to connect with residents and stakeholders. Open houses, town hall meetings, focus groups and community workshops are all tactics that can help ensure that residents play a part in the process to shape planning and development. But what should you know before embarking on a campaign? There are pitfalls nestled among the opportunities. In this session, public relations professionals Sean Casey and Brendan Kennedy will discuss these topics and explore best practices for community outreach.

New York State Paid Family Leave

Effective on January 1, 2018, New York State private employers of all sizes were required to implement the State's new Paid Family Leave Program (PFL). Public sector employers, although not mandated to provide a PFL benefit, can voluntarily opt into PFL under certain conditions. Not every requirement mirrors the requirements of private sector employers so it's important to know how your organization is to proceed. This presentation will provide an overview of the final regulations and detail how employers will work in conjunction with their disability carriers to administer this policy. The PFL will also be reviewed alongside the Family Medical Leave Act (FMLA) and existing leave policies, providing tips and tools for best-practice implementation.

SESSION II

The Compensability Life Cycle of a Claim – Part I

PRESENTERS: PAUL SWEENEY, PARTNER, COUGHLIN & GERHART LLP, AND LARS P. MEAD, PARTNER, COUGHLIN & GERHART LLP

Understanding how a claim progresses from injury to settlement is essential for anyone who deals with workers' compensation in the municipal arena. In Part I of this session, attorneys Paul Sweeney and Lars Mead will provide a broad overview of workers' comp law, and then step back to examine the steps in the life of a claim including: injury reporting, investigation, claim review, independent medical exams (IME), denials and controversion, permanency, scheduled loss of use (SLU) awards, permanent partial disability (PPD) classification and caps, settlement, trials, and appeals.

Managing Diversity in the Workplace

PRESENTER: GAIL HAMEL, FOUNDER, HAMEL RESOURCES, LLC

Gaining increased awareness of diversity, as well as learning to value inclusion, are key concepts to functioning in the 21st century workplace. Session attendees will learn changing viewpoints on diversity and how to apply employee engagement practices to acknowledging diversity. Attendees will also learn how to handle conflict in the workplace that stems from hidden bias, using the platinum rule (do unto others as they would want done to them) instead of the golden rule, and current demographic trends that demonstrate the reality of diversity.

SESSION III

The Compensability Life Cycle of a Claim – Part II

PRESENTERS: PAUL SWEENEY, PARTNER, COUGHLIN & GERHART LLP, AND LARS P. MEAD, PARTNER, COUGHLIN & GERHART LLP

The second part of the compensability workshop will discuss the finer points of labor law and how they can impact a claim, including an understanding of General Municipal Law 207-a and -c, and leaves of absence under Civil Service Law. The presenters will also provide an overview of discrimination prevention laws, such as the American Disability Act and the New York State Human Rights Law. The session will close with an overview of disability retirement, and how new presumption laws can effect it.

Community Surveys: Creation, Distribution, and Effectiveness Measurement

PRESENTERS: SEAN CASEY, SENIOR VICE PRESIDENT, ERIC MOWER & ASSOCIATES, AND BRENDAN KENNEDY, SENIOR COUNSELOR, ERIC MOWER & ASSOCIATES

How effective are surveys for municipalities? Municipal governments often poll residents regarding community initiatives -- What do people think about changes to a neighborhood? What are the priorities for new infrastructure spending? How should the local government invest in emergency equipment or greenhouse gas reduction? -- These are the types of issues that are well-suited for online discussion and debate. But are you willing to follow through on the results if they are not what you expected? This session will help you understand the best ways to solicit opinions from the public, and what to do once you have them.

SESSION IV

The 2019 VFF Cancer Benefit Law

PRESENTER: JOHN HANSON, CONSULTANT, WILLIS TOWERS WATSON

The New York State Volunteer Firefighter Enhanced Cancer Disability Benefits Act, passed in 2017 and effective January 1, 2019, acknowledges the long-term health dangers volunteer firefighters put themselves in when serving their communities. The Act provides for defined monetary benefits should a firefighter be diagnosed with certain cancers, and requires that their fire company provide a new type of disability insurance to pay for the benefits. Attendees at the session will learn all about the new law and receive guidance on how to implement it within their organization.

Conflict Negotiation in the Workplace

PRESENTER: MERCI MIGLINO, TRAINER, CAPITAL DISTRICT EMPLOYEES ASSISTANCE PROGRAM

In this training, participants will learn how to reverse a negative communication climate and more effectively set a positive communication climate with others. Attendees will learn how to avoid conflict-generating statements and actions and how to take responsibility for management conflict, including pinpointing the seven causes of conflict. Finally, participants will utilize all five conflict management styles to practice self-mediating conflict.
